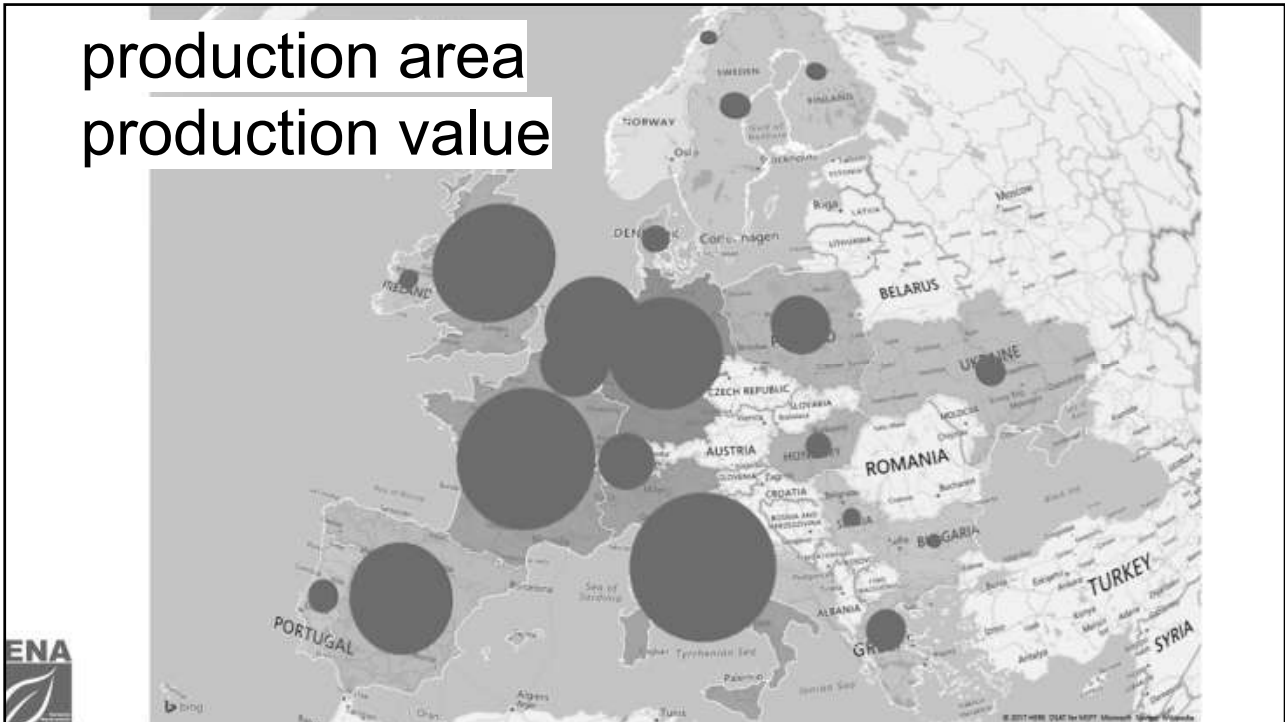



Implementation in EU nurseries & market effects in the EU

- Nurseries: convinced plant health is their best asset
- Implementation / Preparation depends on the country
 - Most countries: meetings / seminars / guidelines soon
 - URGENT: to improve communication Authorities <> Nurseries Org.
 - working systems to adapt, procedures to learn, +paperwork
 - Country authorities ♥ nurseries = easy way → advantage
- Effect on the internal market: very low (same rules for all)
